#### His Impact

Three missionary journeys:

- 1) Acts 13-14 (about 1 year)
- 2) Acts 15:36-18:22 (about 3 years)
- 3) Acts 18:23-21:16 (about 5 or 6 years, with a lengthy stop in Ephesus)

He traveled over 10,000 miles to preach the Gospel at a time when travel did not happen quickly. He helped establish at least 14 churches.

We have 13 letters in our Bible that he wrote: Romans, 1 Corinthians, 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1 Thessalonians, 2 Thessalonians, 1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, Titus, and Philemon.
